Possible Careers and Apprenticeships	<p>Fine Artist: Create original works of art in various mediums, expressing personal or cultural narratives.</p> <p>Photographer: Capture and create visually compelling images for various purposes, including art, journalism, and advertising.</p> <p>Product Designer: Develop innovative and aesthetically pleasing products, considering both form and function.</p> <p>Graphic Designer: Use visual elements to communicate ideas and messages through print or digital media.</p> <p>Art Director: Lead and guide the visual aspects of creative projects, ensuring a cohesive and impactful design.</p> <p>Creative Director: Oversee and shape the creative vision of a project or design team.</p> <p>Illustrator: Create visual representations and interpretations of concepts or stories.</p> <p>3D Modeler/Animator: Develop 3D models or animations for various applications, including games and films.</p> <p>Apprenticeships available: Puppet Maker; Design and make puppets and props for film & theatre.</p>
