Our curriculum is rich with the knowledge to help our students become better thinkers and problem solvers, equipped to understand the complex world around them. Our students will become curious, tenacious and passionate learners who are driven by self-belief and confidence and who understand the value of learning: the curriculum cultivates these qualities. For the first 3 years, students follow a wide range of subjects, all housed in specialist areas. In Year 10 and 11, students choose the qualifications they wish to pursue, as well as continuing studies in English, Mathematics and Science. In the Sixth Form, our curriculum prepares students well for a future in Higher Education, employment and training with an extensive choice of A-Levels, Vocational and Technical qualifications.

Pastoral System
