Enrichment Week 2026

It is with great excitement and anticipation that we extend a warm welcome to you for our upcoming Enrichment Week scheduled to take place from the 20th to the 22nd of July for Years 7, 8 and 9. This week of different and unique activities offers students the opportunity to explore the world outside the classroom.

How to use the booklet?

Within this booklet you will find the details about the packages that are on offer for students to sign up to. Our aim is to provide a range of activities to suit a range of interests and budgets for students. For each activity, you will find a synopsis of the activity, followed by a breakdown of the activities on offer each day and lastly the specific requirements. Please make sure that you pay attention to the specific requirements such as swimming capability and passports and sign your young person up to a suitable activity.

Booking process:

We will be keeping the same booking process as the previous academic year. All activities will need to be booked via ParentPay with the deposit paid at this time to secure the booking. Please do not email in or call via Reception as we are unable to manually book any of the activities. Activity booking will open at **7am on Monday 8**th **December** for half of the spaces available, with the second half of the booking going live at **7pm on Monday 8**th **December.** We have done this to ensure that to the best of our ability parents and carers are able to book around their working or caring commitments.

All packages have a maximum number of spaces due to transports and/or places available at the venues we have booked.

Important:

Activities may not appear on ParentPay simultaneously as the system will work its way through making them available at the set time. This is due to the ParentPay system. We recommend keeping an eye on the activities as they become available. You will also be asked information such as the passport number if you are booking an abroad residential, we suggest having this information to hand.

ParentPay:

ParentPay is the system used by the College for parents to pay to book a place for Enrichment Week. Please go to www.parentpay.com. Should you have any issues

regarding ParentPay please contact our Finance department via the email finance@eggbuckland.com

Consent:

Students' details will be extracted from SIMS for off-site visits to include parent/carer contact details, medical information and allergies. Please ensure that you inform the College of any changes in personal details. The act of booking and paying for your child's package on ParentPay represents consent for them to participle in that chosen package and activities.

Payments:

All trips have flat deposit of £10 to secure a place. Deposits will need to be paid at the time of selecting the chosen trip on ParentPay on the day of booking. Each trip will have a recommended payment plan which you may choose to follow, or you may pay in one instalment. All trips must be paid in full by the 1st of June 2025, all payments must be paid in order for your young person to take part in the activity.

To enhance your experience, we have categorised the activities into four pricing tiers, ensuring accessibility for all families. The categories are as follows:

If parents pay in one instalment, instalment plans do not need to be followed.

Please note, these are approximate costs based on all full trips and this year's prices. Some vendors have informed us those prices may change for the following year. We will always inform parents of the updated cost as soon as we can.

Cancellation of Eggbuckland Community College Trips:

If an Eggbuckland Community College trip is cancelled by the company that is organising it, this will result in a full refund for the student. However, if a student books their place and subsequently cannot or does not wish to attend, unless another student is found who can take their place, **the student is still liable for the full cost of the event**. If there is an exceptional circumstance, such as illness or injury resulting in a student being unable to attend the trip, a suitable doctor's note will be required in order to proceed with an insurance claim.

Behaviour:

Student behaviour at College directly impacts their eligibility to participate in certain activities. If staff determine that a student's behaviour poses a risk to their own safety or the safety of others, they may be excluded from the activity, a partial refund may be issued, and parents or carers will be contacted—each case will be reviewed individually.
