We suggest students:

- Highlight all of their exams.
- Highlight all of the subject-specific revision/prep sessions relevant to them.
- Set out their own revision timetable for during the Easter holidays, weekends, evenings and May half term.

STUDENT/PARENT/CARER INFORMATION:

- Students **MUST** register every single lesson.
- In all examinations, unless written on the front of the examination paper all students must write in black ink and will need to bring their own scientific calculator to Maths, Science and Geography exams (and other option examinations).
- Students should have at least one spare black pen, a pencil and ruler with them, all of which must be held in a transparent pencil case.
- Specific examinations will require specialist equipment, for example a compass and protractor.
- Mobile phones and other such devices, including watches, must not be taken into the examination hall. Pockets must be completely empty (even of blank paper) in the exam venues.
- Students have been emailed detailed guidance about malpractice, along with assemblies around this. The exam boards make decisions around sanctions linked to malpractice and take any cases of malpractice seriously with severe consequences (sanctions range from a formal warning up to being unable to receive a grade in any GCSE subject). If in doubt, ask an invigilator before the examination.
- Morning examinations will start at 09:00.
- Afternoon examinations start at 13:15.
- On the day of any examination, if there is reason for absence (i.e. Doctors 'Fitness for work' note) or a student is 'running late', immediate contact must be made with the Examination Office via telephone (via reception: 01752 779061). We will always try and admit a student who arrives slightly late, however, this is not guaranteed. There is no opportunity to 're-sit' any examination. Contact should also be made to the attendance office in the normal way.
- If you are unable to attend for any reason, your parent/carer must inform us at the earliest opportunity, as we are inevitably concerned if a student does not arrive for an examination.
- Any student who has been entered for an examination and who fails to attend without a good cause, will be responsible for the costs involved.
- You will receive a personalised timetable, including seating arrangements before the mock examinations. This must be checked in extreme detail, and any errors raised immediately with the Examination Office.
- If there are any queries at this point, please inform the Examinations Office in the first instance (exams@eggbuckland.com).
- Where there is not another arrangement you must attend your usual timetabled lessons. **You must be registered in every lesson until completing your Science exam on Monday 15th June. Note that on Friday 12th June, some students will leave site from approximately 14:45 after their exam.**
- If there is a discrepancy with this and your personalised exam timetable you **must** follow the instructions on your personalised exam timetable.
- Students must note that as a centre we must strictly follow JCQ regulations around conducting examinations, which includes formally reporting any potential malpractice.
