Possible Careers and Apprenticeships	<p>Fine Artist: Create original works of art in various mediums, expressing personal or cultural narratives.</p> <p>Illustrator: Create visual representations and interpretations of concepts, often for books, magazines, or digital media.</p> <p>Photographer: Capture and create visually compelling images for artistic or commercial purposes.</p> <p>Graphic Designer: Use visual elements to communicate ideas and messages through print or digital media.</p> <p>Art Director: Lead and guide the visual aspects of creative projects, ensuring a cohesive and impactful design.</p> <p>Curator/Art Gallery Manager: Organise and manage art exhibitions in galleries or museums.</p> <p>Art Teacher/Instructor: Educate and inspire others in the world of art, either in schools or community settings.</p> <p>Visual Effects Artist: Create digital effects for films, animations, and other visual media.</p> <p>Apprenticeships available: Art Therapist; Use visual art media to help people who struggle to express their feelings verbally to confront difficult and often distressing, emotional issues.</p>
