All about this core qualification

- English Language is a compulsory subject at GCSE.
- Students will develop a wide range of communication and interpretation skills. This is a fantastic qualification which will empower students by developing a diverse range of essential skills for life.

What will you study?

- Reading: you will read a wide range of nonfiction texts, including texts from pre-1900.
- Writing: you will write for a wide range of audiences and purposes, non-fiction and creative.
- Spoken Language: you will present to an audience and respond to questions. This is assessed separately from the GCSE.

How will you be assessed?

There are two examinations:

- Paper I (50%): Explorations in creative reading and writing.
- Paper 2 (50%): Writers' viewpoints and perspectives.
- Spoken Language: Presenting and responding features in the assessment of this GCSE.

- AS Literature.
