# How students can make a real difference

Work hard and take part in every lesson.

Go to tutor and turn up on time.

Lessons start promptly. (3 mins late per lesson is about 10 hours over a year)

Attend all Period 6 lessons (when they begin).

Complete all homework – get help from your teacher before the deadline if needed

Lee Elliot Major recommends up to 10 mins of Homework / Revision per night per school year. Year 10 = 1 hr 40 mins. (https://www.youtube.com/watch?app=desktop&v=VIRyFJhE6Rc)

Developing their abilities to overcome problems.


Organising themselves over longer periods of time.

Completing more work at home independently.

Understanding the exam structure and exam dates.

Planning and carrying out revision. Set time limits rather than task limits to reduce stress.

Practice, Practice - Perfecting their exam technique.



# How you can help

Get extra snacks and drinks in.

Agreeing a balance between work and social life.

Schedule physical activity.

Encouraging persistence and helping with motivation.

Calm communication.

Having a plan to deal with excuses.

Helping with preparation and organisation.

There will be morning and afternoon mock examinations.


The structure of these will follow processes that are used in formal examinations.

More information, including the mock exam timetable, to follow nearer the time. What you need to know currently is in the course and revision booklet.









### **FAQs**

#### **Revision:**

- Ihr 40mins per night is expected during Year 10. More can be completed at weekends.
