- Set out their own revision timetable for during the holidays, weekends, evenings and half term.

## **Key points for mocks for all Students:**

- You will receive a personalised timetable, including seating arrangements before the mock examinations. If there are any queries at this point, please inform the Examinations office in the first instance. Seating must be as per your personalised timetable or prior arrangement based on evidence. We cannot accommodate any seating change requests on the day of examination.
- You are responsible to ensuring you have the correct paper, additional equipment before the examination commences. If you are unsure, ask an invigilator.
- JCQ guidance will be followed. If you are unsure regarding this, please see the JCQ website (<a href="https://www.jcq.org.uk/exams-office/information-for-candidates-documents/">https://www.jcq.org.uk/exams-office/information-for-candidates-documents/</a>). If you are still unsure, ask an invigilator or your class teacher.
- Where there is not another arrangement you must attend your usual timetabled lessons.
- Note that as part of contingency planning, these examinations could be used to support a final awarded grade (<a href="https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/guidance-on-collecting-evidence-of-student-performance-to-ensure-resilience-in-the-qualifications-system">https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/guidance-on-collecting-evidence-of-student-performance-to-ensure-resilience-in-the-qualifications-system</a>).
- After any examination (unless it is breaktime or lunchtime) you must return to your normal timetabled lesson to be registered. Your teacher will be providing taught revision or content.
- Students released from an exam after 14:55, and have no period 6 may be released straight home. Note that it is also likely some afternoon exams will finish past the end of the normal college day. Students are required to stay for the duration of their examination.
